Christmas Buffet Noon Dinner and Tour at West Overton: A delicious meal in the

museum dining room with choice of Stuffed Steak (red or brown sauce), Stuffed chicken breasts or Chicken Marsala, potato and veggies plus cake for dessert. After, a Self-guided museum tour showing various industries spawned at this location. A guided tour of the Overhold Homestead and learn how people in the 19th century celebrated Christmas.
