## INCLUDED, With a local guide:

- Johnstown Flood National Memorial, site of the South Fork Dam that failed sending a devastating flood into the city of Johnstown on May 31, 1889 taking the lives of more than 2200 people.
- Johnstown Flood Museum where you view an Academy Award winning film, The Johnstown Flood, an excellent depiction of the events of that day and those following. Many interesting exhibits throughout the museum that was once a Carnegie Library.
- Grandview Cemetery where you see nearly 800 graves of the unknown victims of the flood.
- Lunch at one of the area's fine restaurants.
- As time permits, the Johnstown Heritage Discovery Center with its Immigration History and the Iron and Steel Gallery.
